## Itinerary

### Day 1 Hometown - Calgary

Arrive today in **Calgary**, known as the "Cowboy City." Our staff will be waiting to greet you at Airport **Exit 7** and transfer you to your hotel. (Free airport transfer available from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM, scheduled every 2 hours.)

Hotel: Coast Calgary Downtown Hotel & Suites by APA / Ramada Plaza by Wyndham Calgary Downtown / Aloft Calgary University / Four Points by Sheraton Calgary Airport or Similar

### Day 2 Banff National Park

Begin the day exploring **Banff National Park**, Canada's first national park. Take an optional ride on the **Sulphur Mountain Gondola** for panoramic views of the Rockies, walk through **Johnston Canyon**, and visit landmarks like **Bow Falls**, **Surprise Corner**, and the wind-carved **Hoodoos**. Enjoy a free time in **Banff Town** for shopping and dining.

Hotel: Banff Aspen Lodge / Banff Mount Royal / Elk + Avenue Hotel / Banff Inn / Banff Park Lodge / Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa or Similar

### Day 3 Jasper (Columbia Icefield)

In the morning, drive the scenic **Icefields Parkway** into **Jasper National Park**. Stop at **Bow Lake** to admire the mountain reflections. Visit the **Columbia Icefield**, where you can optionally join the **Ice Explorer** ride to get on the Athabasca Glacier. Admire the vibrant glacier-fed waters of **Peyto Lake**, and finish with a view of **Crowfoot Glacier's** unique formations.

Hotel: Whistlers Inn Hotel / Lobstick Lodge / Jasper Inn & Suite or Similar

### Day 4 Jasper National Park-Calgary

Enter **Jasper National Park** and be greeted by **Mount Robson** (3,954 m), the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Explore **Maligne Canyon**, marveling at its deep gorges and cascading waterfalls. Visit **Maligne Lake**, where glacier-fed waters shine emerald blue amid majestic mountains and ancient ice. Pass by the **Medicine Lakes**, and back to Calgary.
