## Highlights

- [Columbia Icefield]**  
One of North America's largest ice masses, the Columbia Icefield spans the Rockies. Ride the Ice Explorer onto the Athabasca Glacier for an up-close glacial experience.
- [Lake Louise]**  
Known as the Jewel of the Rockies, this emerald-green lake is surrounded by mountains, perfect for canoeing, hiking, or relaxing at the lakeside café.
- [Moraine Lake]**  
Famed for its blue waters in the Valley of the Ten Peaks, the lake mirrors the surrounding mountains and is especially stunning at dawn.
- All optional admissions and activities depend on suppliers' daily operations and may change without notice.
- If closure of any sightseeing point occurs, it will be replaced by alternative attractions.
- The itinerary sequence, hotel arrangements, tour guide, and vehicle might be subject to change due to departure date, but the core itinerary and services will remain the same.
- The basic tour fare excludes: driver and guide gratuities (CAD\$15 per guest per day), national park entrance fees and breakfast (compulsory selection during booking), 5% GST (Goods & Services Tax), optional activities during the tour, personal expenses, lunches and dinners, and airfare.

### Day 1 Home – Vancouver/Seattle

Customers arriving at Vancouver Airport before 12:00 PM receive a complimentary 3-hour city tour or outlet shopping with a 10%-off VIP voucher. Flight information must be provided at least three days prior, or the service will be forfeited.  
Hotel: Accent Inn Richmond OR Hampton Inn Richmond OR SureStay by Best Western Richmond OR Travelodge by Wyndham Richmond or Similar

### Day 2 Vancouver – Fraser Valley – Merritt – VQA Brewery – Kelowna – Okanagan Lake – Revelstoke

If arriving a day early, airport pick-up and a pre-tour hotel can be arranged. Depart Vancouver in the morning, traveling along Fraser Valley Highway to a semi-desert town. Visit **VQA Brewery** to taste and purchase Canadian wines, pass by **Okanagan Lake** with its legendary Ogoogo, and continue to Kelowna. End the day in **Revelstoke**, a historic railway town surrounded by abundant wildlife and home to the Revelstoke Dam.  
Hotel: Revelstoke Sandman Hotel or Vernon Sandman Hotel or Similar

### Day 3 Roger Pass – Yoho National Park – Lake Louise – Bow Falls – Banff

Travel through Roger's Pass, a scenic mountain route in the Selkirk Mountains, to **YOHO National Park**, named for a Cree expression of awe. Visit **Lake Louise**, famed for its turquoise waters and mountain backdrop, then **Moraine Lake/Ten Peaks Valley**, with glacier-fed waters surrounded by peaks and waterfalls. Continue to **Banff National Park**, see **Bow Falls**, and optionally ride the **Banff Sulphur Mt Gondola (Optional)** before free time in Banff Town.  
Hotel: Banff Aspen Lodge or Similar (or pay extra to stay at featured hotels - Banff Mount Royal or Elk + Avenue Hotel or similar)

### Day 4 Bow Lake – Columbia Icefield (Ice Explorer/ Glacier Skywalk) – Athabasca Falls – Jasper Town

Travel from Banff to Jasper National Park along the scenic **Icefield Parkway**, passing turquoise lakes, glaciers, waterfalls, and wildlife. Stop at **Bow Lake**, explore the **Columbia Icefield** with optional glacier experiences, see **Athabasca Falls**, and end in **Jasper Town**, a charming mountain community.  
Hotel: Whistlers Inn or Mount Robson Inn or Lobstick Lodge or Similar

### Day 5 Jasper – Maligne Lake – Maligne Canyon – The Crossing – Peyto Lake – Crowfoot Glacier – Calgary Airport

Continue exploring Jasper National Park, passing diverse mountain landscapes and pristine wilderness. Visit **Maligne Lake** with optional **cruises** to Spirit Island, and explore **Maligne Canyon**, a deep limestone gorge. Pass **Medicine Lake**, marvel at **Peyto Lake** with its turquoise, fox-shaped waters, stop at **The Crossing**, and observe **Crowfoot Glacier**, an ancient ice formation showing the effects of climate change.  
Return to Calgary Airport after tour. Please book flight departure after 21:30PM or book Extended Stay with us
