Itinerary

Day 1 Hometown - Calgary

Arrive today in **Calgary**, known as the "Cowboy City." Our staff will be waiting to greet you at Airport Exit 7 and transfer you to your hotel. (Free airport transfer available from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM, scheduled every 2 hours.)
Hotel: Coast Calgary Downtown Hotel & Suites by APA / Four Point by Sheraton Airport or similar

Day 2 Banff National Park

Begin the day exploring **Banff National Park**, Canada's first national park. Take an optional ride on the **Sulphur Mountain Gondola** for panoramic views of the Rockies, walk through **Johnston Canyon**, and visit landmarks like **Bow Falls**, **Surprise Corner**, and the wind-carved **Hoodoos**. End the day with free time in **Banff Town** for shopping and dining.
Hotel: Banff Aspen Lodge / Banff Mount Royal / Elk + Avenue Hotel / Banff Inn / Banff Park Lodge / Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa / Irwin's Mountain Inn or similar

Day 3 Jasper National Park (Columbia Icefield)

Departing this morning, we travel past the magnificent **Crowfoot Glacier** and **Bow Lake** as we enter **Jasper National Park**. You will have the option to take the **Ice Explorer (Snocoach)** onto the ancient Athabasca Glacier, experiencing the awe of standing atop 250 meters of glacial ice (Optional). We then proceed to **Peyto Lake**, nestled beneath Caldron Peak, whose water famously exhibits a dreamy Tiffany blue hue due to glacial rock flour deposits reflecting the sunlight. The evening concludes as we return to the vibrant **Banff Town** for the night.
Hotel: Banff Aspen Lodge / Banff Mount Royal / Elk + Avenue Hotel / Banff Inn / Banff Park Lodge / Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa / Irwin's Mountain Inn or similar

Day 4 Moraine Lake - Lake Louise - Rogers Pass

Head to **Moraine Lake**, a hidden gem in the Valley of the Ten Peaks, renowned for its crystal-clear waters and surrounding snow-capped mountains. Next, explore the jewel of the Rockies, **Lake Louise**, whose glacier-fed waters shimmer in stunning shades of blue. Guests on the inclusive meal plan will savor a **deluxe lunch** at the hotel. Travel west along Highway 1, passing through the **Rogers Pass** and overnight in **Vernon/ Kelowna**.
Hotel: Holiday Inn Express Vernon / Comfort Suites Kelowna or similar

Day 5 Kelowna - Okanagan Lake - Vancouver

This morning, we visit **Okanagan Lake**, a clear, deep, and tranquil body of water famed for its magnificent scenery. The lake is further imbued with legend due to the long-standing mystery of the serpent-like creature, "**OGOPOGO**". We then proceed to a certified **VQA Winery**, where we sample representative red, white, and Icewines, experiencing the unique charm of Canadian winemaking culture. Continuing westward, we pass through **Merritt** before arriving in **Vancouver** in the evening.
Return to Vancouver around 8:00 PM, or book an Extended Stay with us

[Columbia Icefield]

As one of the largest ice masses in North America, the Columbia Icefield stretches across the Rockies, offering a truly breathtaking glacial landscape. Choose to ride the Ice Explorer onto the Athabasca Glacier to experience the glacier's mystery and grandeur up close.

[Lake Louise]

Reputed as the Jewel of the Rockies, this lake boasts emerald green waters and is encircled by mountains, creating a picturesque setting. Canoeing, hiking, or simply resting at the lakeside cafe are all perfect ways to relax and rejuvenate.

[Moraine Lake]

Famous for its blue waters embraced by the Valley of the Ten Peaks, the lake's surface is crystal clear, perfectly mirroring the magnificent surrounding mountains. It is particularly mesmerizing at dawn, making it a paradise for photographers and nature lovers alike.
